The Managing Director and Directors recognise that they have a Health & Safety responsibility to ensure that all reasonable precautions are taken to provide and maintain working conditions which are safe, healthy and comply with all statutory requirements and codes of practice which relate to the company employees, customers and public associated with Pioneer Pump working activities.

The company will; so far as it is reasonably practicable, pay particular attention to:-

- The provision and maintenance of plant and systems of work providing a framework for setting and reviewing OH&S objectives.
- Arrangements for ensuring safety and absence of risk to health in connection with the use, handling, storage and transportation of all articles and substances.
- A commitment to prevent injury and ill health and continual improvement in OH&S management and OH&S performance to ensure the health and safety of all employees and others.
- To control and maintain the place of work in a safe condition including a safe means of access and egress.
- Include a commitment to comply with applicable legal requirements and with other requirements to which the organization subscribes that relate to its OH&S hazards.
- The maintenance of a working environment that is safe, without risk to health, and provides adequate facilities and arrangements for welfare at work.
- The provision of all necessary safety devices and protective equipment and supervise their proper use.
- Maintain continual communications with employees on matters of health and safety.

Employees at all levels have a duty and responsibility to co-operate in the operation of this policy and to:

- Work safely and be responsible for their own acts and omissions.
- Not to interfere with any item of equipment or system that is provided for the health, safety and welfare of employees.
- Use the personal protective equipment provided.
- Report all accidents, dangerous occurrences and near misses no matter how minor.
- Adhere to company procedures designed to secure a safe working environment.
- Assist in the investigation of accidents with the objective of introducing measures to prevent recurrence.

This Policy will be reviewed annually and communicated to all employees. The policy statement will be made available to all interested parties upon request.
